



Russell Square (East Ballarat) Running Track



Note 1: The above picture is a photo of the current running track at Russel Square (outlined in yellow). The pink arrows indicate the direction of the track. The track is 1km in distance. 5,6,7 & 8yo will do 1 lap, 9 & 10yo will complete 2 laps while 11 & 12+yo will complete 3 laps of the track. The race will begin and finish from the clubrooms of the Ballarat North Soccer Club.

You will also see I have labelled "point areas" in "white" eg: point 1, 2 etc these are the points where we will need to have staff/parents located. There will also be pink arrows on the track (between marshals) so students know which way to run.
